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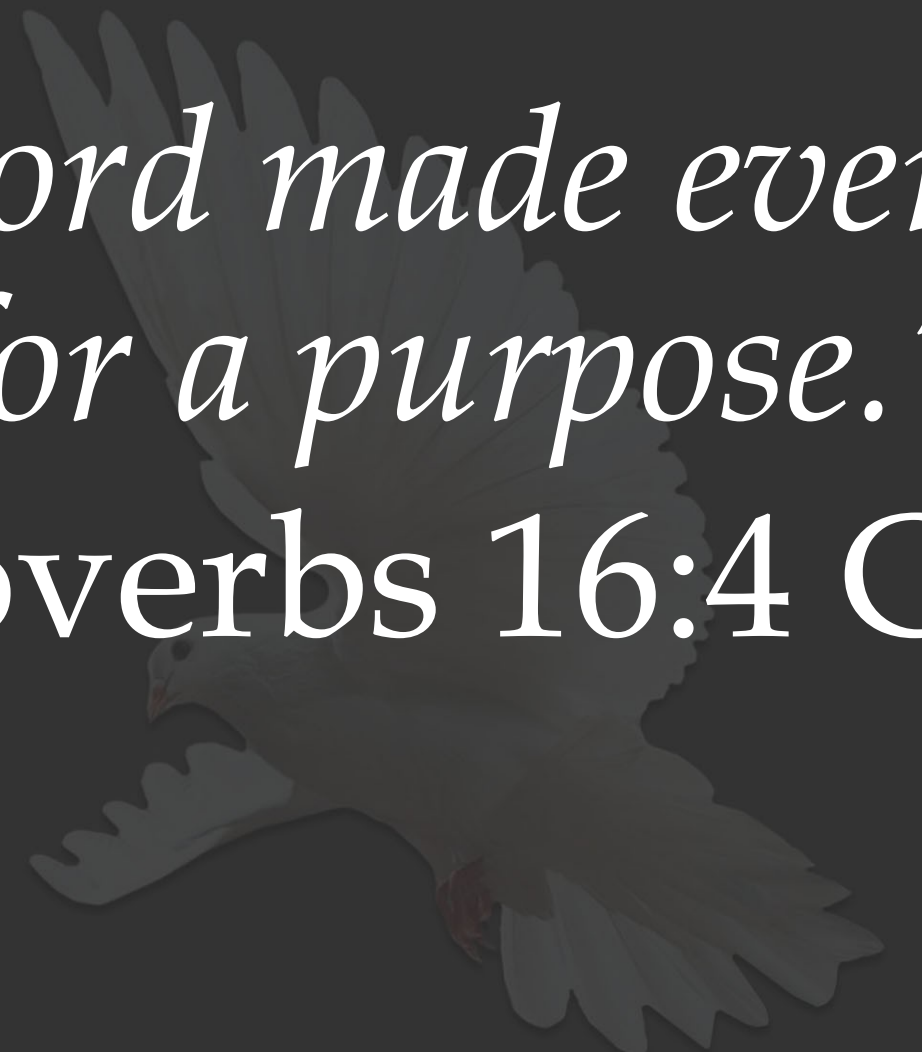

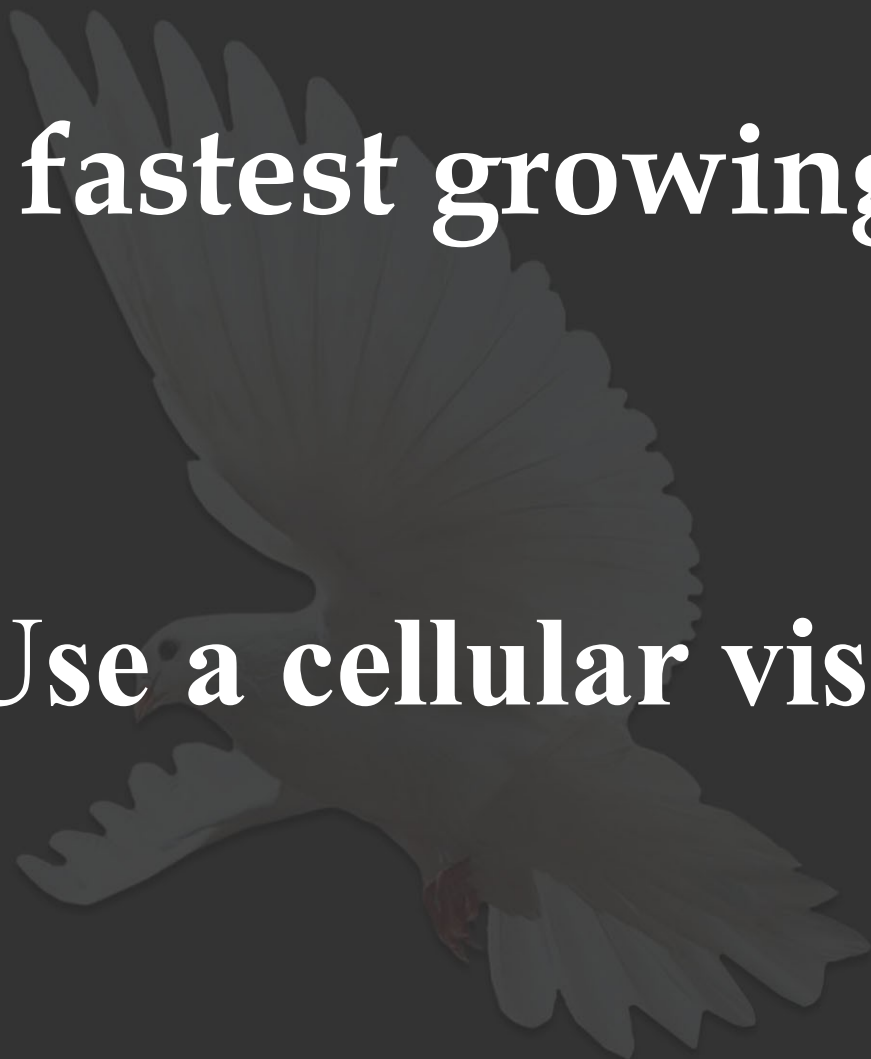

...Use a cellular vision.





Origins of the Cellular Vision

The Cellular Vision...

...has a Biblical Foundation and a
Solid Historical Development.



We have to be sure that everything the church does...

...is based on the Bible and on Christ.

The cellular vision comes from the Bible.

“having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, 21 in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord.”

Ephesians 2:20,21 NKJV

Exodus 18

Moses received the strategy of placing leaders over the people:

- Leaders of 10
- Leaders of 50
- Leaders of 100
- Leaders of 1000

Jesus' Ministry

Jesus developed an effective ministry in the homes:

- He taught the word (Luke 10:38,39)
- He healed the sick (Luke 4:40)
- He fellowshiped with his friends (Matthew 9:10)

The Early Church...

...taught, disciplined, prayed and fellowshiped in the homes.

Mary's House (Acts 12:12)

House of Priscilla and Aquila (Romans 16:3-5
and 1 Corinthians 16:19)

Nymphs' House (Colossians 4:15)

- Archippus' House (Philemon 2)

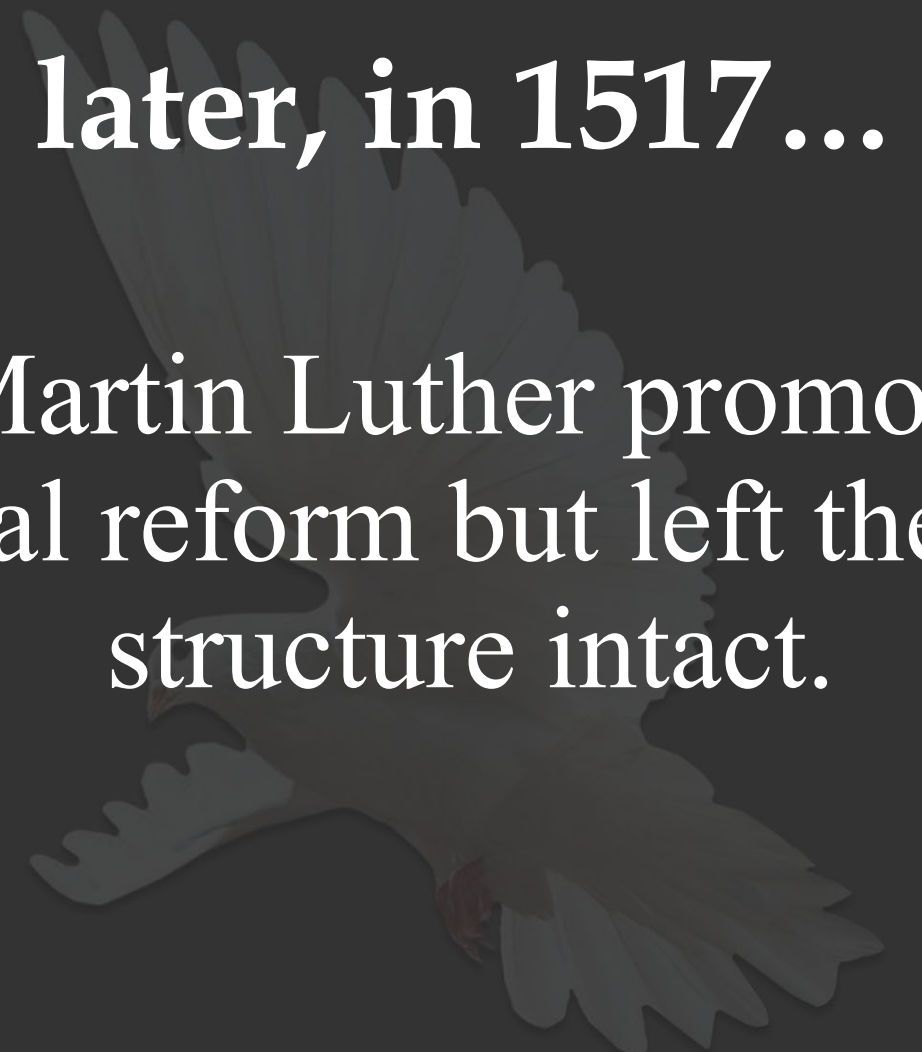
For 300 years...

... Martin Luther promoted a
theological reform but left the ecclesial
structure intact.



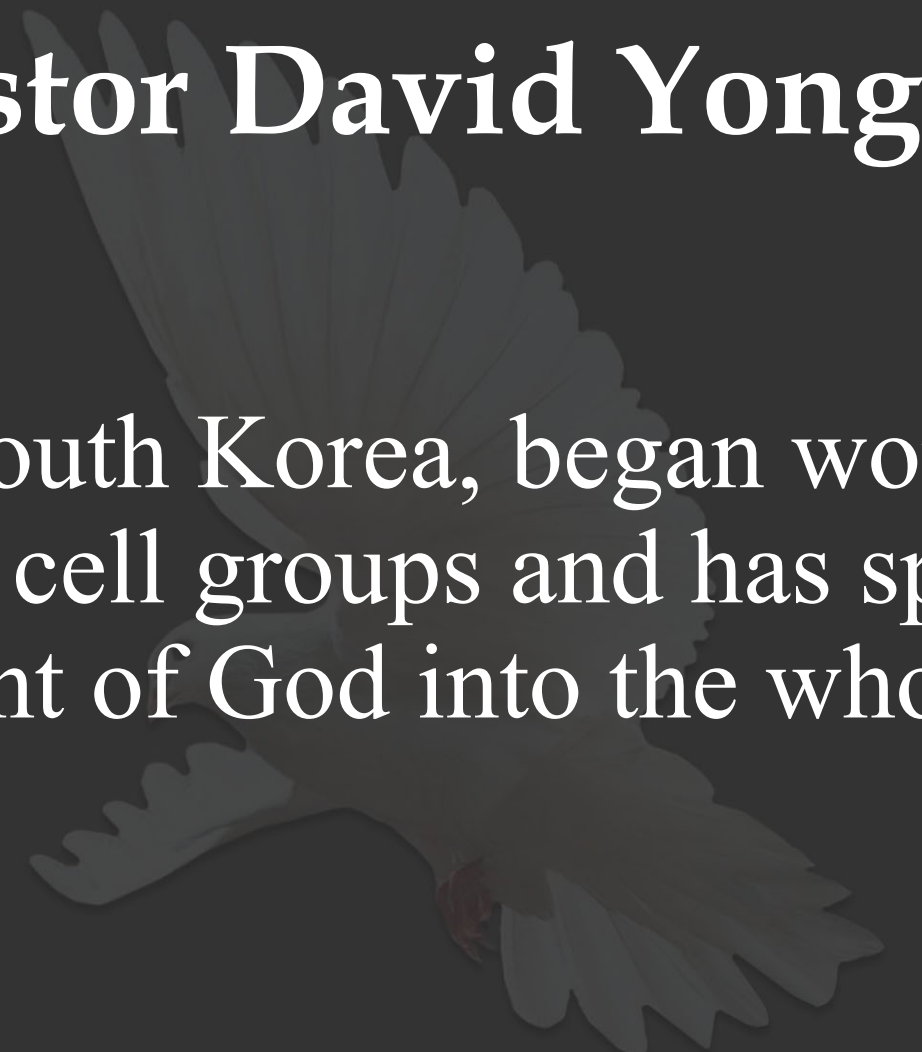
In 1738 John Wesley...

...organized small groups of saints.

By the end of his life, he had managed to open 10,000 cell groups, with an average attendance of 100,000 people.

In 1964 Pastor David Yonggi Cho...

...from South Korea, began working with 20 home cell groups and has spread as a movement of God into the whole world.

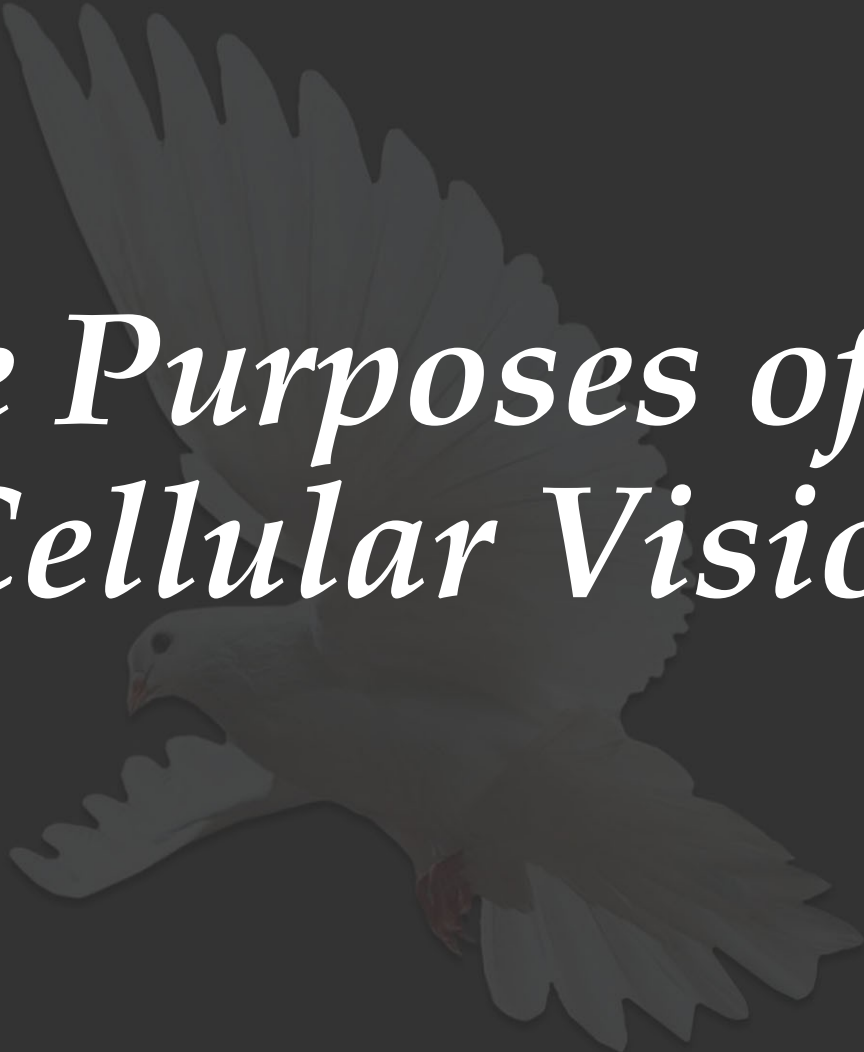




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The Purposes of the Cellular Vision

Cell Sectors (Leaders of 50)

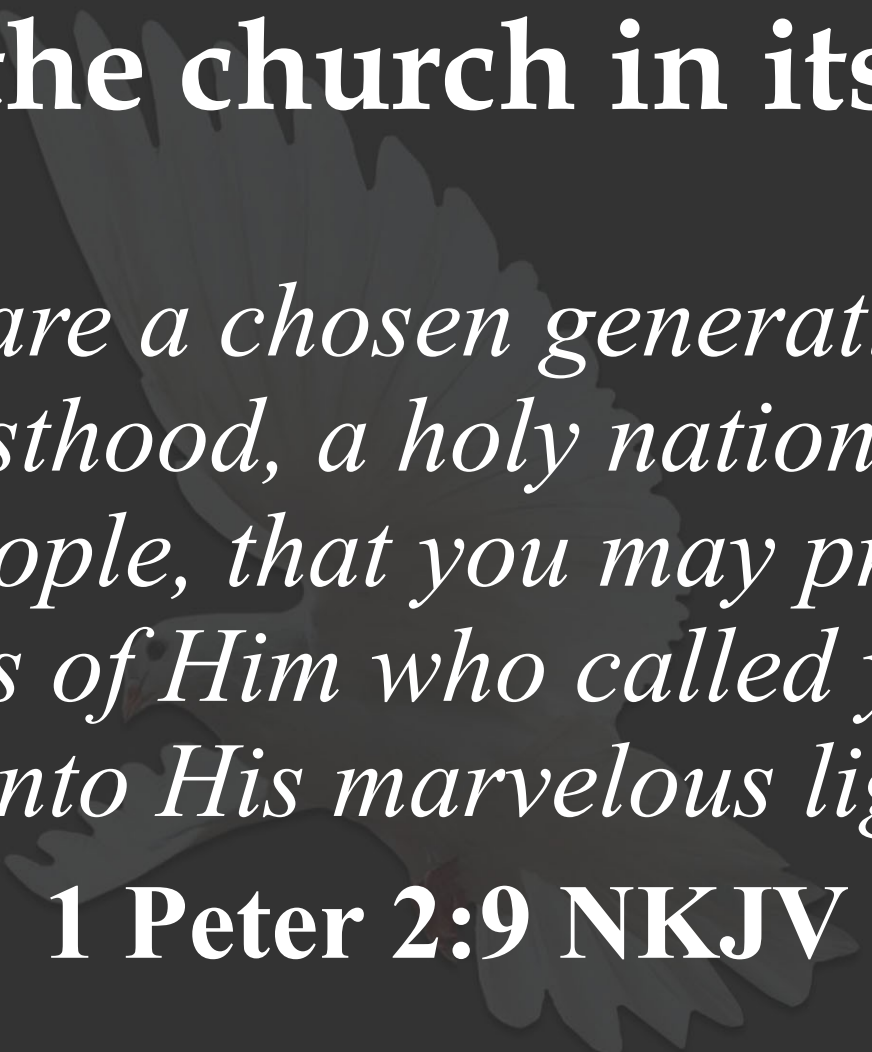
- Cells (Leaders of 10)

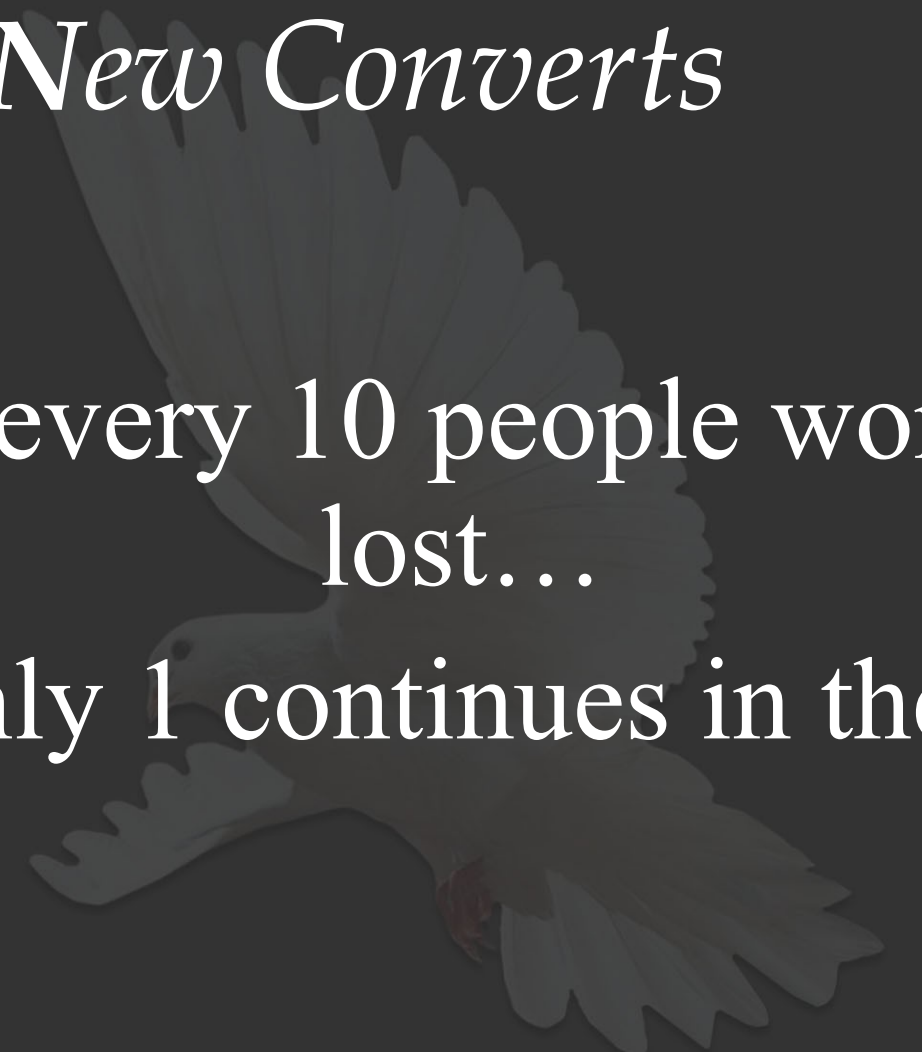

...and only 1 continues in the church.



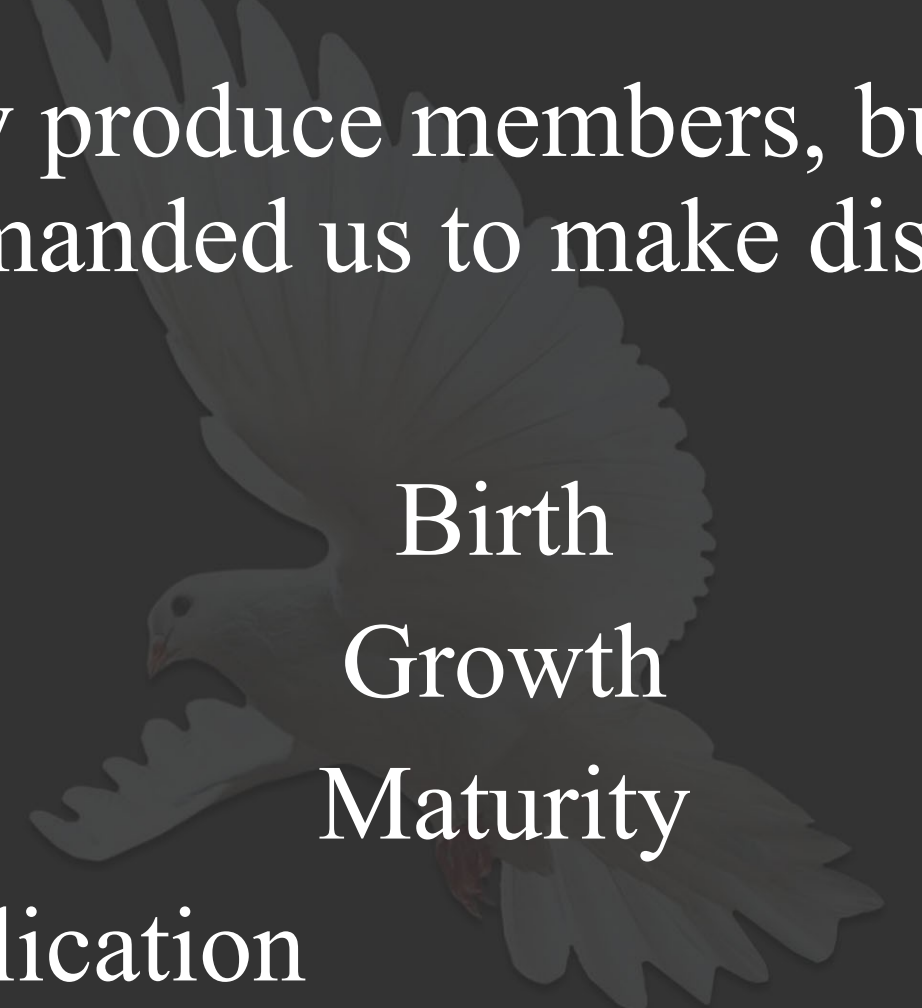
The Discipleship Balance Is Missing

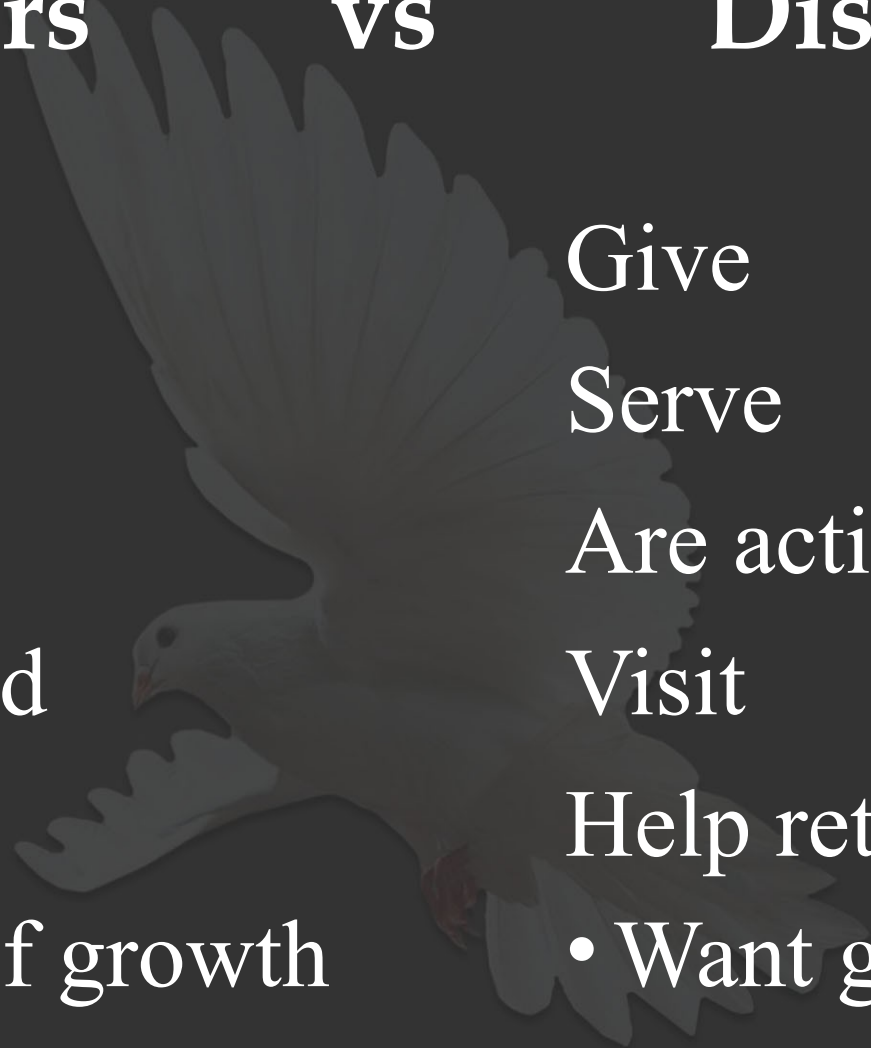

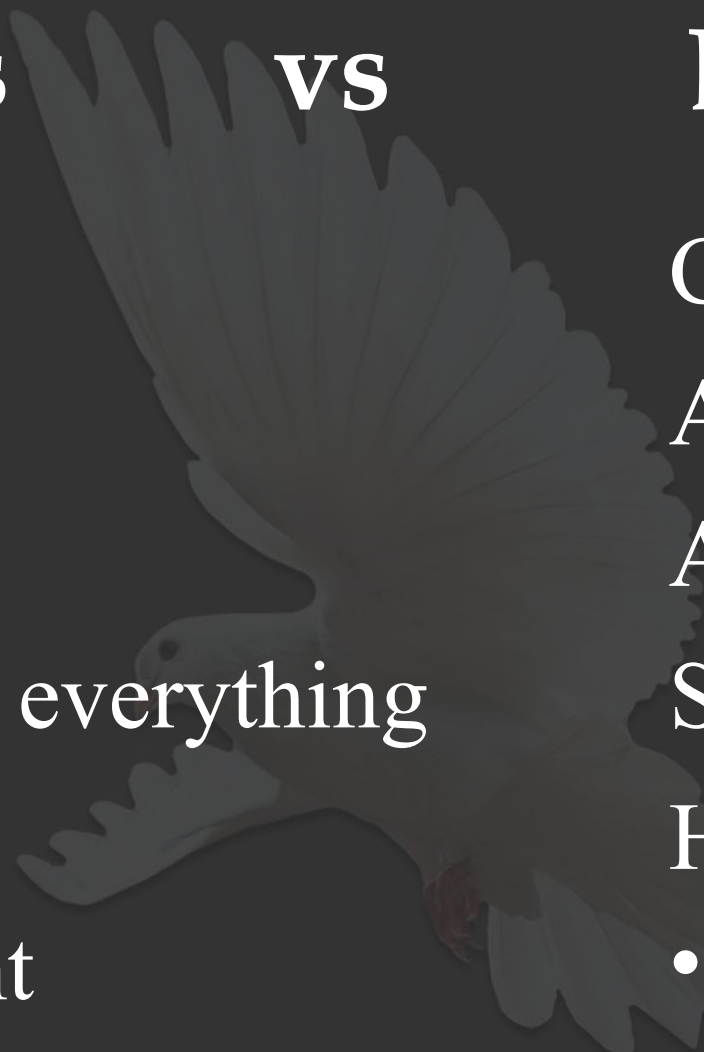

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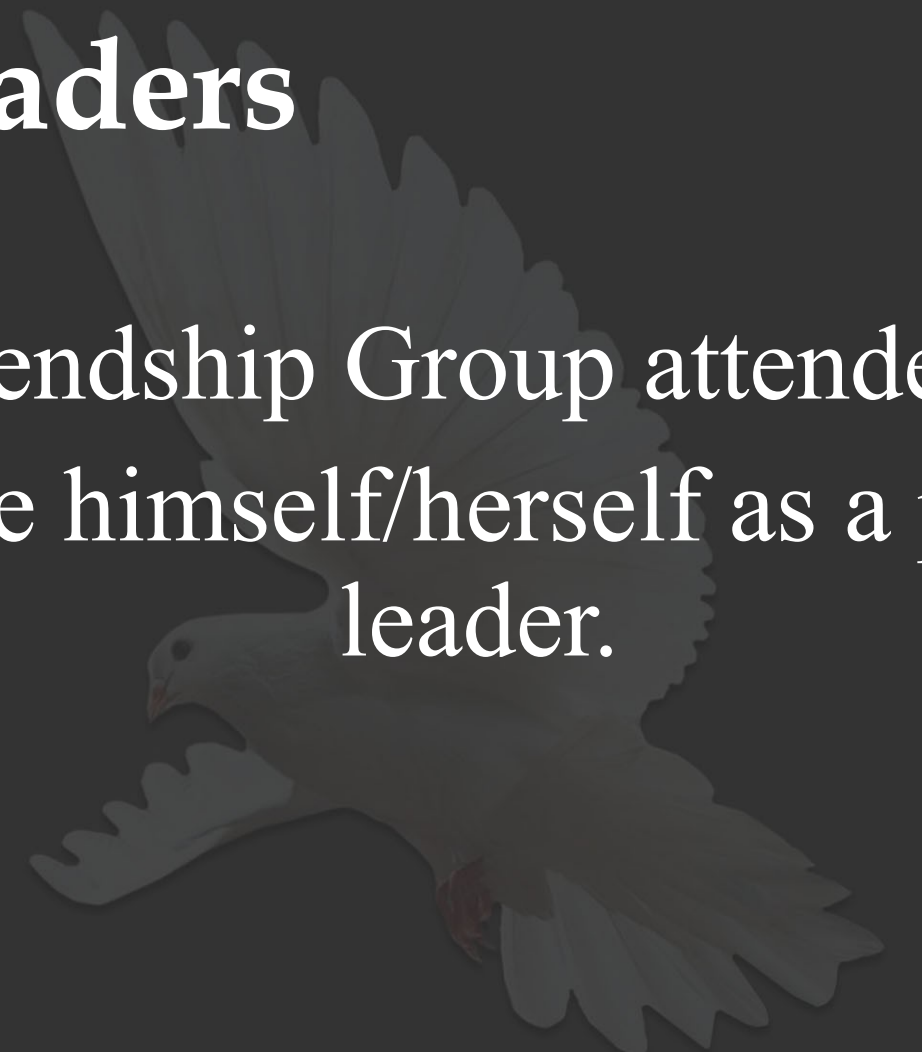
Disciples are not born,

5. Train leaders

Each Friendship Group attendee
must see himself/herself as a potential
leader.



If we have 10 attendees in a FG...

...and if we develop them,
we will get 10 Friendship Groups
with at least 100 people gathering.



Jesus invested 3 and a half years...

...training 12 leaders.

- He gave them a cause and a Vision.

These 12 then revolutionized Jerusalem
and the Roman Empire.

Whole church mission involvement

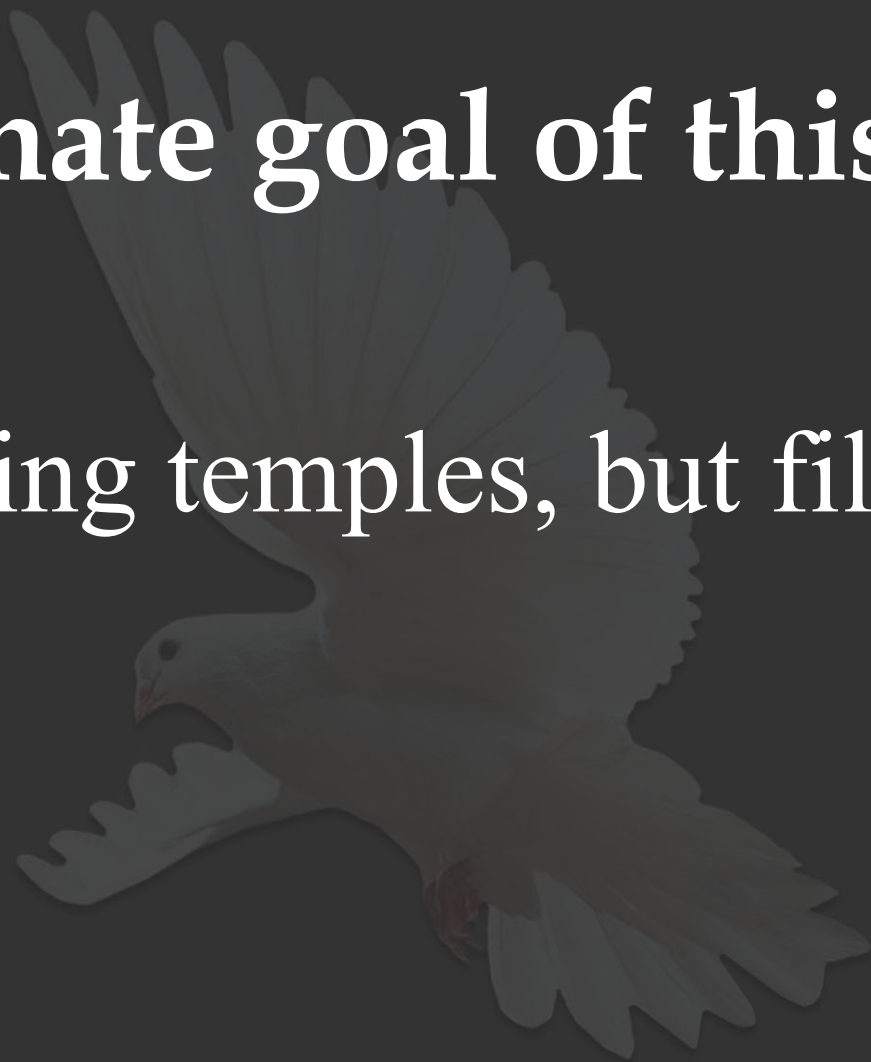
Win the lost
