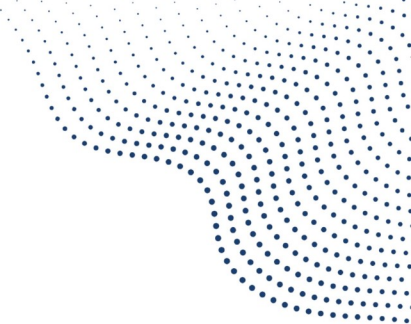

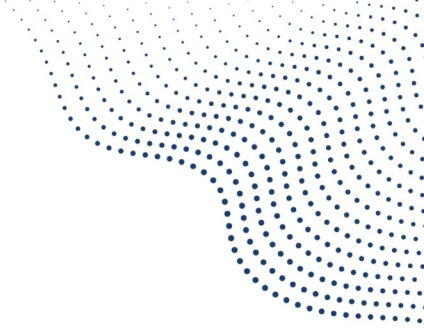

Reach the Lost World!

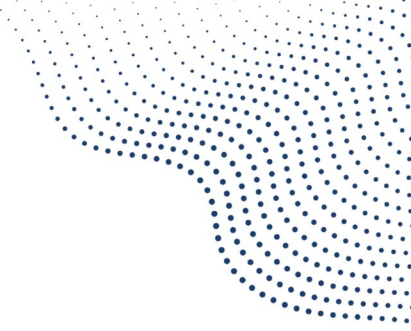
●●● God provides resources for the vision

Financial (money)

Material (goods, property, equipment)

People (people specialized skills, leaders)

- Spiritual (gifts, anointing, wisdom)

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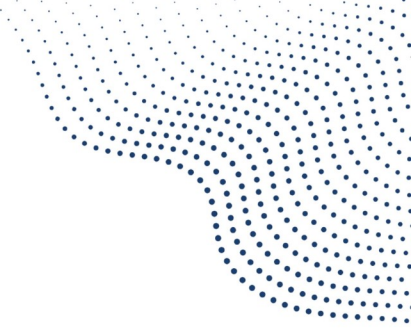
The MEET Meeting



Vision Is Managed

(The Strategy of Jesus and Its Purposes)

At the MEET Meeting, the pastor can weekly influence his leaders, refresh their vision, and evaluate them.

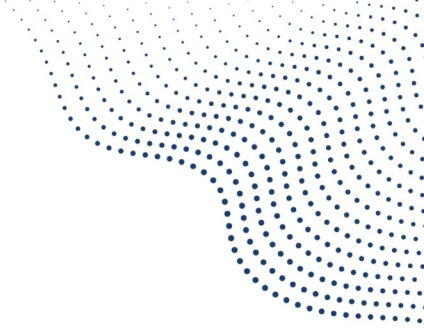


The Pastor's Influence...

...will determine the results of the Church.

The pastor is the #1 promoter of the vision.

**Leaders need to hear the vision from their
pastor every week.**



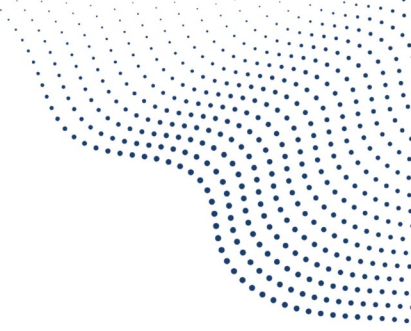
Influence

The ability to *shape the leaders' thinking.*



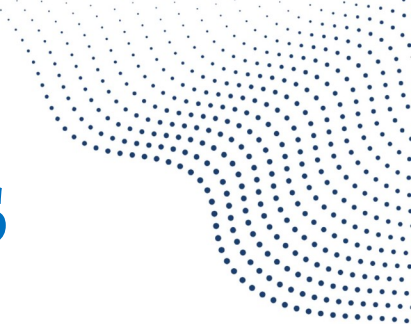
The Pastor's leadership will be measured...

...by his ability to influence the leaders to follow the vision, of their own volition.



Accountability

It is critical that every leader, to whom authority is delegated, be *held accountable* for his/her stewardship.



Accountability Has Benefits

Motivates the leader to make an effort

Prevents stagnation

Unites the leader to the vision

Ensures that the leader is not following another vision

Guides the church toward results

1. Promotes the leader's faithfulness to the Pastor

MEET is the practical description of the meeting:

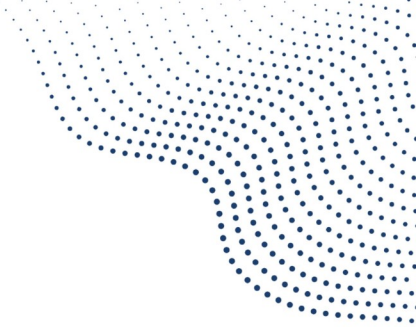

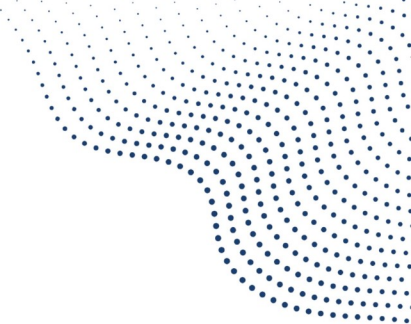

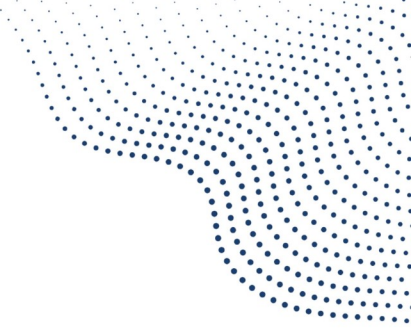


The FG Leader...

The MEET Meeting

At the MEET Meeting, *the leaders report results, their work is recognized*, they are encouraged and motivated, and personal intercession is made on their behalf.

Strength

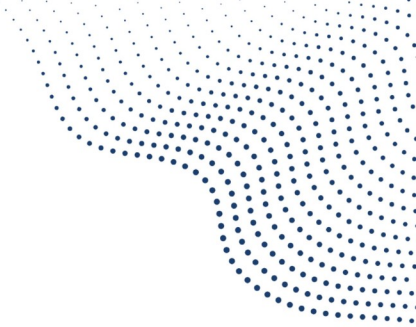
Vision

Evaluate





The goals and results achieved must be evaluated each week.

It is important to recognize the leaders for their good results and motivate them to work on the areas that may be deficient.

Evaluation is a dialogue, not a monologue, between the corresponding authority and his subordinates.

How many friends did we write down?

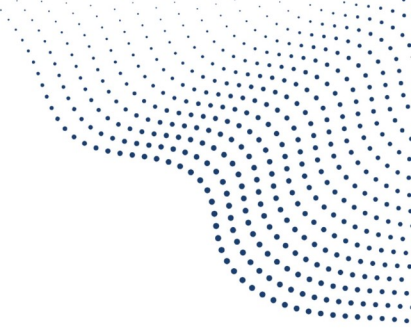
How many friends did we take to Friend's Day?

How many friends did we connect to the FG?

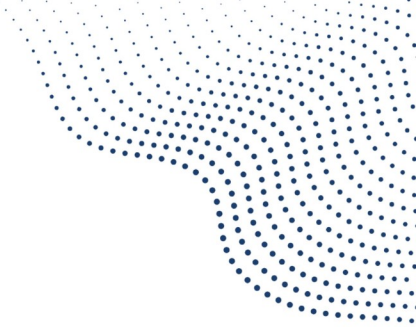
How many friends did we take to the Retreat?

How many friends did we enroll in the Birth Discipleship Follow Me School?

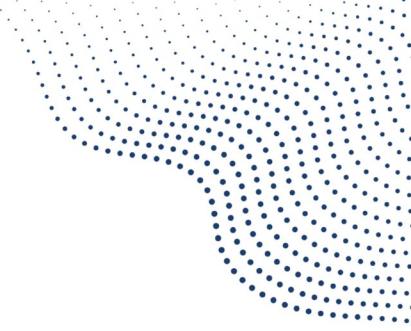
How many friends did we baptize?

Friendship Groups.



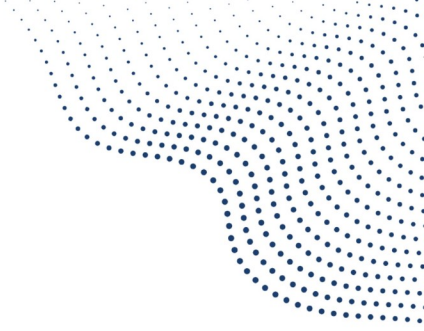
Empower

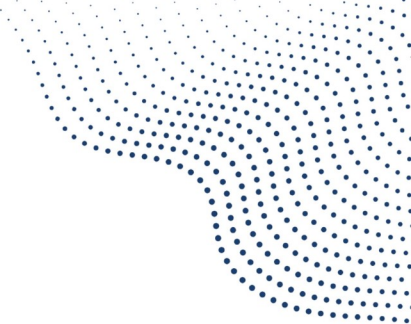

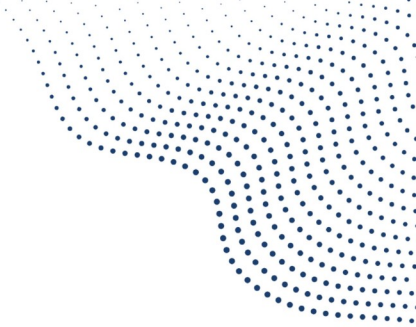

It is important for every leader to attend faithfully, because:

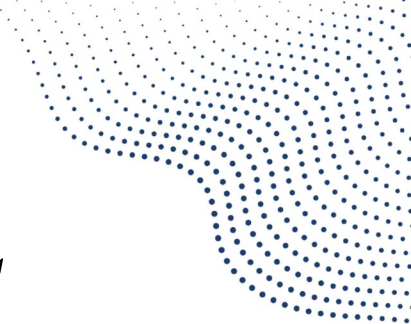


Short-term goals are set for the week

- Work adjustments are made, based on the results

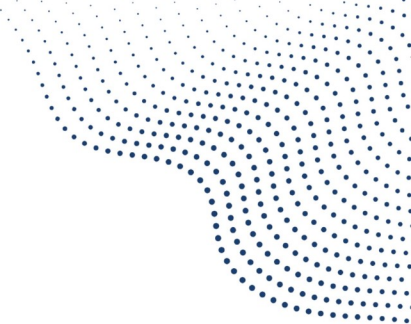
