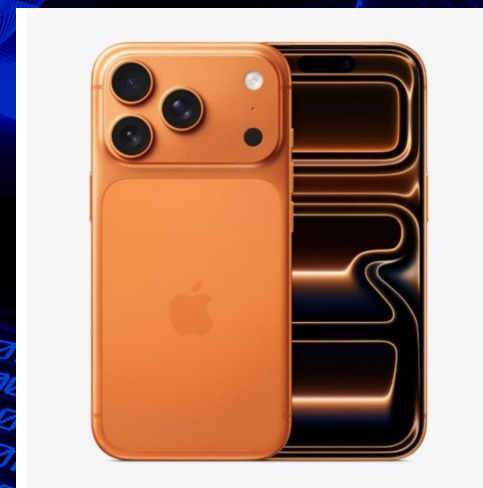

Why Do Churches Die?

The lack of a clear **vision** of the future

They cling to and yearn for the **past** so much that they want to relive it

The Church grows old

Relationships with the community deteriorate

1. **Concern for survival**, rather than satisfying the needs of the congregation

Vision

“Vision is a divine revelation that helps the church become effective in its mission.”



*“Where there is no revelation [vision], the people
cast off restraint.”* **Proverbs 28:19**

Millennials

They are 30% of the world's population

In the United States, they are 22 to 25% of the population

40% claim to have no religious affiliation; they are called "the nones"

Only 10% identify as evangelical

They call themselves Exvangelicals; they flee religion

They consider religion to be for old people

80% support same-sex marriage

1. They live according to Christian ethics that have no doctrine or dogma

How to Transition

1. Pray to God for Wisdom

“If you want to prosper, you have to know what to do and do it well.”

Ecclesiastes 10:10 TLA

2. Convey the Vision to Your Pastoral Team

“Write down the vision, and make it plain...”

Habakkuk 2:2

3. Plan

“Whoever fails to plan, plans to fail.”

“For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it?” Luke 14:28 NKJV

4. Teach

Prepare the church for the change to be:
Wise
Sensitive

- Firm

Motivate: tell of the benefits of the new way of working.

Teach the abc's... concepts, etc.

5. Develop Leaders

Choose future leaders.

“Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. 13 And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles.”

6. Make Incremental Changes

Do not change the structure right away.

Make gradual changes.

7. Be Patient
